Member Spotlight: Omemee Food Bank

Did you know the Omemee Food Bank was established in 1992? The minister and congregation of Anglican Christ Church saw the need in their community, and with Lindsay being the closest food bank, transportation was a major obstacle. The food bank was launched as an initial 3-month pilot project and, 30 years later, it's still serving the community.

Food Literacy Program: Community Kitchen

The Community Kitchen is an exciting initiative under KLFS' Food Literacy Program. It provides six families with necessary ingredients, cooking equipment,

and instructions, so they can prepare a different set of recipes each week for five weeks. Cooking classes are taught virtually by the program's coordinator, Tamara, so participants can tune in online and follow Tamara stepby-step as they make the dish for themselves.
