## Wrap Ups:

### Summer Outreach Lunch Program

Over the course of the summer, **1,384 lunches were made**. 832 were distributed to children at the locations and the remaining lunches were provided to A Place Called Home. **31 volunteers donated over 515 hours to help bake, prepare and distribute the lunches.**



### Open Garden

Open Gardens are vegetable gardens planted and maintained by volunteers, providing fresh, nutritious food to those in need, and are accessible and free to anyone to use. People are welcome to harvest at any time, and as often as needed. there was 202 kilograms of food harvested from the garden that was distributed to our food banks. Thank you to the **Ontario Association of Food Banks and Sysco through their Feeding Fresh Sysco Community Garden Program. Currently there are 44 raised beds in two locations.** An additional 12 beds will go in later this fall and will be completed in the spring of 2019 bringing the total to 56 raised beds for the 2019 growing season.
