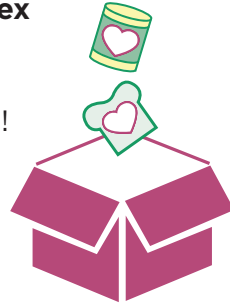


Learning the gift of giving at a young age!

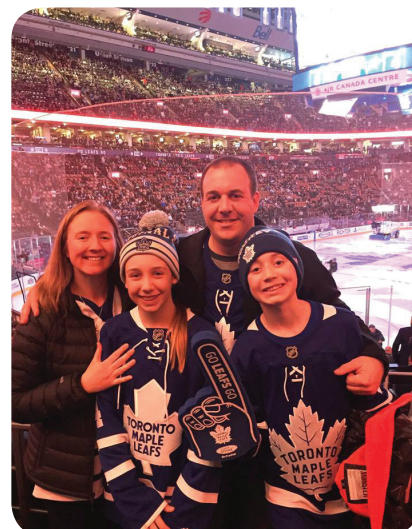
Oh what a night!

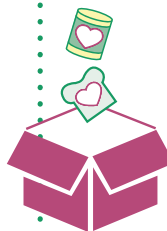
